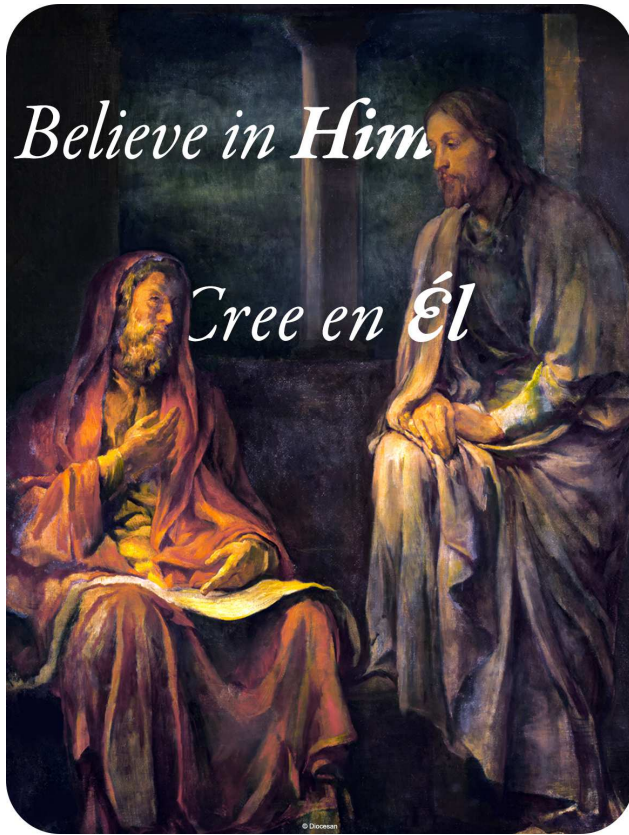

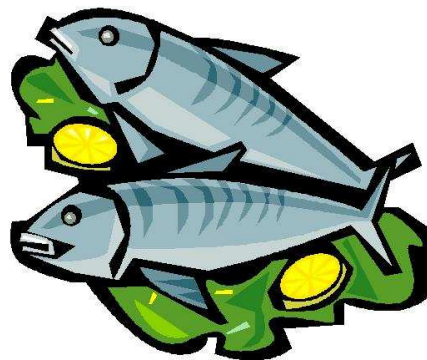

Greetings, Parishioners. This weekend our fifth-grade students hosted the 5pm mass. I big thank you to their teacher, Mr. Alex, for preparing our students, and to their parents for instilling our Catholic faith in their children. We are blessed.

Once again, our students will be partnering with the Catholic Council of Women in their spring service project collecting donations for the FLITE Center. FLITE (Fort Lauderdale Independence, Training & Education) Center was created in 2009 through a partnership of the Community Foundation of Broward, the United Way of Broward, and the Junior League of Greater Fort Lauderdale, with the intent of offering comprehensive access to services for youth aging out of foster care. The FLITE

Center has become the hub of all support services for youth transitioning out of foster care to become successful adults within a safe, nurturing environment that promotes personal growth while developing practical life skills.

We are blessed to once again partner with the Catholic Council of Women in this very important service project. We are thankful to CCW for their support and guidance of our school children and families.

Enrollment for new school families continues. As of today, we have 29 percent more students enrolled for the 2024-2025 school year than we did last May for the current school year. This is a testament to the hard work and dedication of our Pawmazing faculty and staff, supportive parents, and wonderful students. I am also grateful to you, the parishioners of St. Jerome, for your unwavering support of our school. 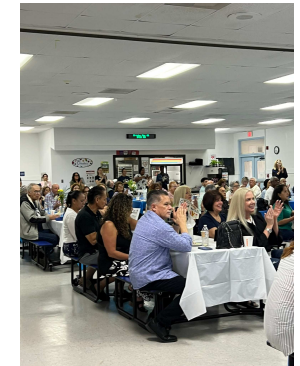

spoons, pots and pans.

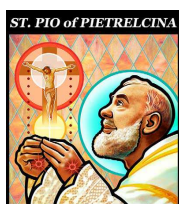
