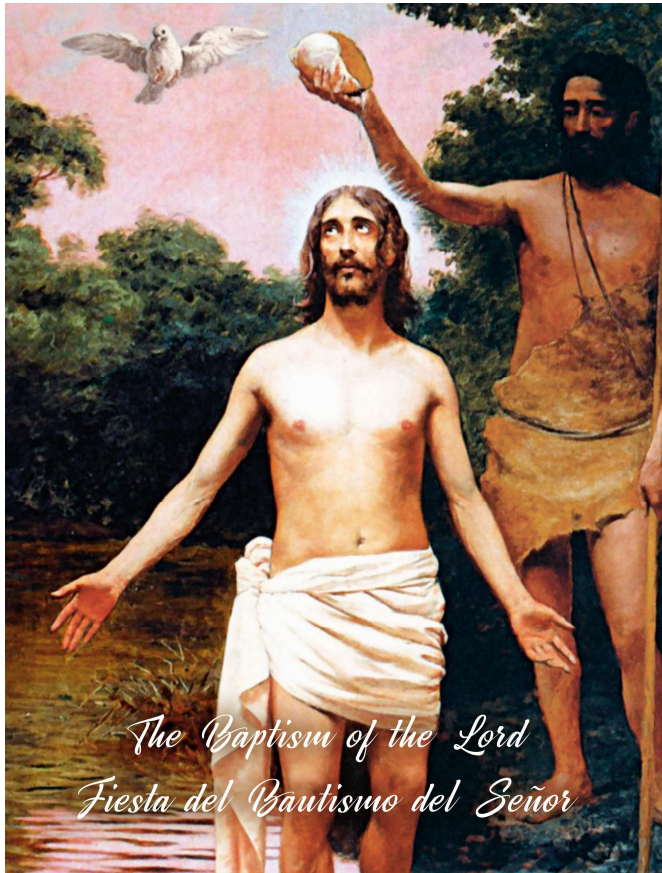

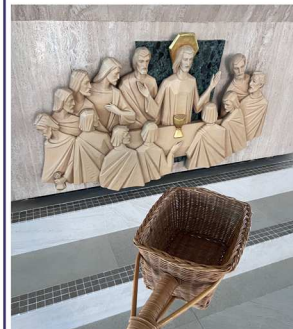

Re-enrollment opened last Monday for our current school families for the 2025-2026 school year. How blessed are we to continue to serve our St. Jerome families year after year.

Last Friday, we celebrated our January Saint of the Month. These are students who are chosen by their teachers who exemplify the qualities of the Saints. May we all strive to become a Saint. This Friday, our 8th grade class will attend a field trip to Kennedy Space Center. This is a wonderful opportunity to inspire the next generation of space explorers. Our students will launch into a galaxy of fun and learning through authentic NASA science, technology, engineering, and math. The Kennedy Space Center has a rich history and today it is active as America's multi-user spaceport. During the field trip, our students will come face-to-face with Space Shuttle Atlantis, explore the massive 363 foot-long Saturn V moon rocket at the Apollo/Saturn V Center, tour NASA's spaceflight operation, interact with immersive simulators and exhibits, and so much more. We are grateful to our Pawsome junior high science teacher, Mrs. Green; and our faculty and staff, who make this learning experience possible. We are also thankful to our Panther Parents for their support in our off-campus learning experiences. We continue to interview for a prekindergarten teacher assistant effective immediately. It is my blessing to serve as your principal. I wish you a blessed week.

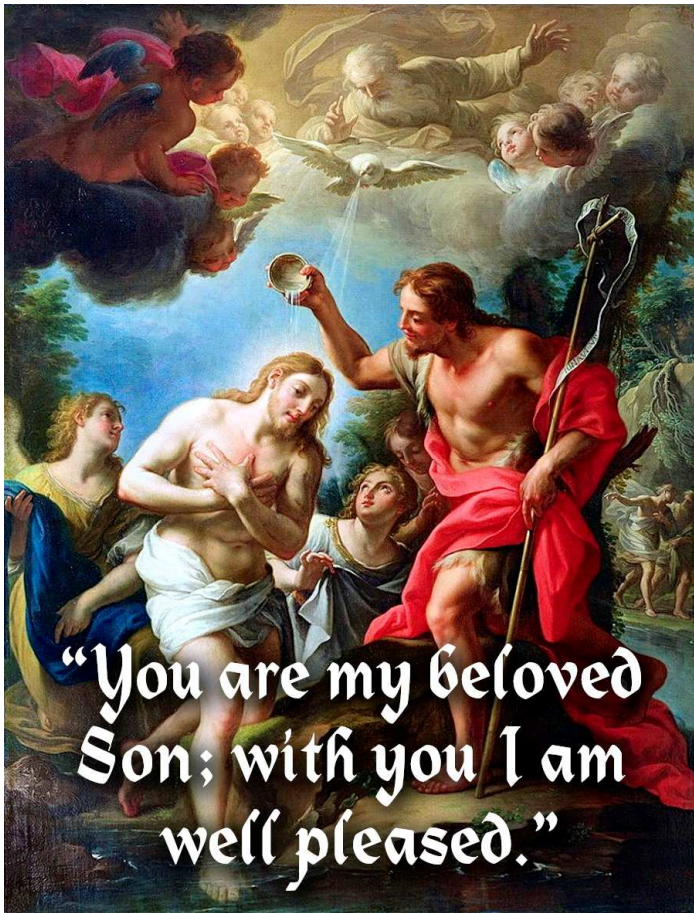

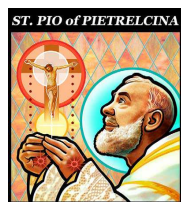
