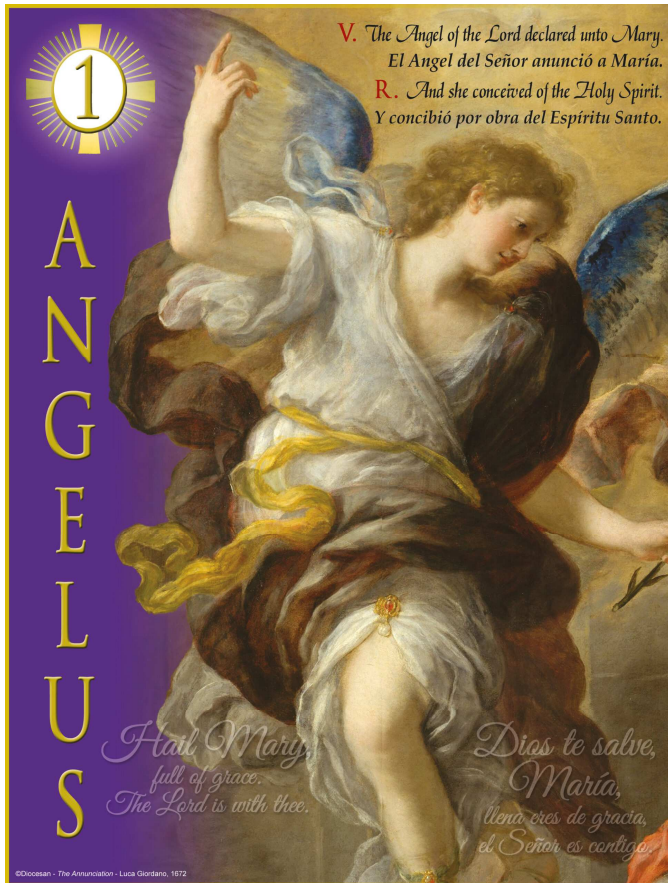

From Your Principal...



Greetings, St. Jerome Parishioners, on this first Sunday of Advent. Today we begin a new season of hope and preparation. Advent is a time for watching, waiting, and preparing for Christ. Let us make a concerted effort to prepare for our Lord this Advent season.

Our school has completed our third-year review as part of our accreditation process. We had a wonderful review.

Mary Camp, the Associate Director of Accreditation for Florida Catholic Conference; Dr. Latonya White, Associate Superintendent of the Archdiocese of Miami; and Barbie Perdomo, Early Education Specialist for the Archdiocese of Miami, visited our school on

Friday, November 22nd. I am thrilled to share some of their findings with you: *The principal and pastor began their ministry at the school in the 2021-2022 school year. By that fall, there had been excellent progress. Now, three years later, the growth is tremendous.

*The school culture embodies the mission. *Catholic identity is evident throughout the campus and classrooms. *The school has a well-developed and active school advisory council. The leadership along with the SAC have created a strategic plan that guides the work. *The newly created Religion and Academic Coordinator is already an asset to the overall success of the school and in the support of teachers. *Students are supported through several pullout programs. Students now have opportunities to participate in academic competitions and NJHS. *Parents have more opportunities to be involved, including Home and School. *Buildings and grounds are well kept. *Enrollment is a main priority with a focus on excellent customer service.

*Security was also a priority and the results are evident with the outdoor PA, security guard, police officer, locked doors, etc.

*The director ensures that the program is an amazing entry to the school. She is passionate about the school and the prekindergarten program. The evidence provided was incredible. Some of it will be shared with others as best practice.

Thank you for your support of St. Jerome Catholic School. It is my blessing to serve as your principal.

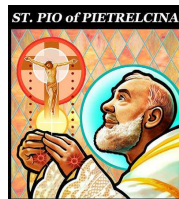
