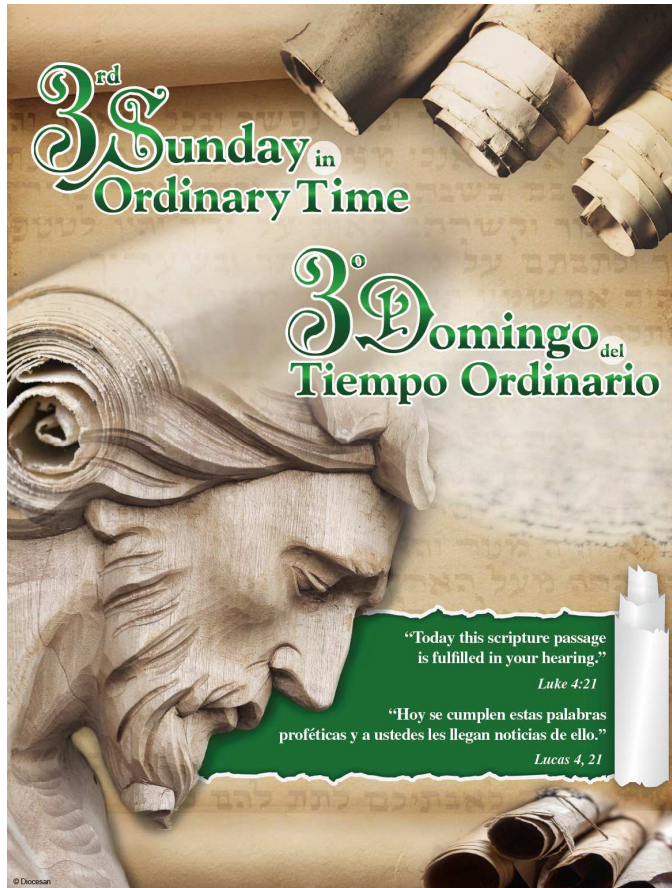

It is my blessing to serve as your principal. I wish you a blessed week.

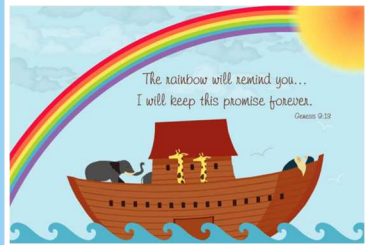

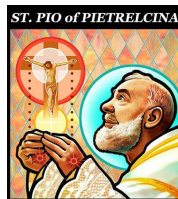
