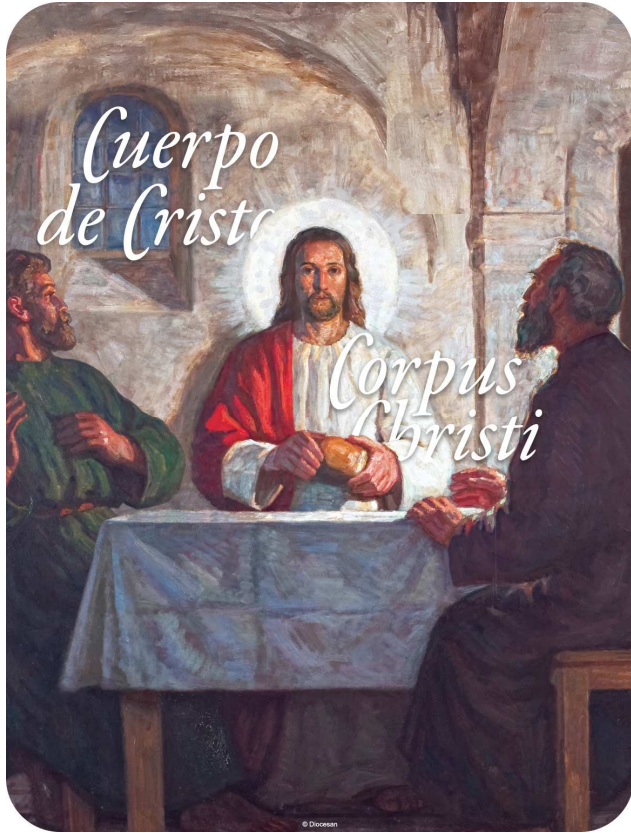

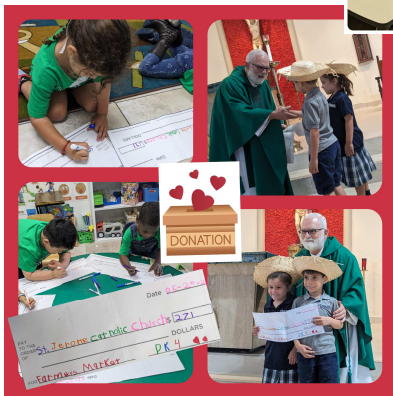

WE WILL VISIT:

In Paris: The Montmartre neighborhood and its Basilica of the Sacred Heart. The Chapel of "Notre Dame de la Medaille Miraculeuse. Enjoy the dinner cruise on the Seine river.

In Lisieux: The Basilique of Saint Therese (known as Saint Therese of the child Jesus), the Sanctuary (les Buissonnets) of Lisieux and the "Cathedrale of St Pierre".

In Paray Le Monial: Visit places dedicated to "Sainte Marguerite Marie Alacoque", in the Basilica of the Sacred Heart. Margaret Mary Alacoque was a French Catholic Visitation nun and mystic who promoted devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

In Ars Sur Formons: The wax museum, the Basilica, both dedicated to "St. Jean Vianney". Transfer to Dardilly where we will visit the house of St Jean Vianney, and the church.

In Avignon: Visit the Palace of the Popes; It is one of the largest and most important medieval Gothic buildings in Europe. Once a fortress and palace, the papal residence was a seat of Western Christianity during the 14th century. Six papal conclaves were held in the Palais.

In Lourds: Sanctuary of our Lady of Lourdes. In the afternoon visit of church of St. Bernadette, and her paternal house. The Marian (torchlight) procession at 9:00 pm.

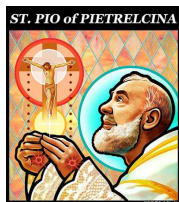
